

IN 1375 – IMO Guidelines on Maritime Cyber Risk Management

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The latest **IMO Maritime Safety Committee** (MSC98) approved a joint MSC-FAL circular on Guidelines on maritime cyber risk management, based on the [Interim guidelines on guidelines on maritime cyber risk management](#) (MSC.1/Circ.1526).

The Guidelines contain high-level recommendations for maritime cyber risk to safeguard shipping.

This document defines functional elements that include: identifying, protecting, detecting, responding, and recovering with respect to cyber events.

Best practices are also discussed with additional guidance mentioned in standards produced by, inter alia, **BIMCO**, **CLIA**, **ICS**, **OCIMF**; **ISO/IEC 27001** Standard on Information Technology; and **United States National Institute of Standards and Technology's** Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity (the NIST Framework).
